

## COMPETITION INFORMATION

- No entry fee for solo events.
- All solo competitors must have paid admission.
- You may enter only one grade.
- Medals and trophies awarded for all events except those noted.
- Field entry accepted for tenor, bass drum and drum major only.
- Band meeting will be in pipers tent at 11:00 a.m. Please have a band representative present.
- Tents with tables and chairs will be available to bands at cost.
- **Band Entry Fee - \$35 U.S. per event**
- **A band must consist of at least 5 Pipers, 2 snare drummers and 1 bass drum. These numbers must be present at both massed band parades and in any contest in which the band participates to be eligible for travel or prize monies.**
- **An accurate count of band members attending the event must be sent with entries.**

## BAND TRAVEL ALLOWANCE

Up to 100 miles - \$250

101 - 300 miles - \$400

Over 300 miles - \$500

Travel allowance limited to first 20 bands to register.

Bands must participate in both massed bands to receive travel allowance.

All bands must be entered one week prior to the event to receive complimentary admission to the games by mail. Canadian entries should be posted one week earlier.



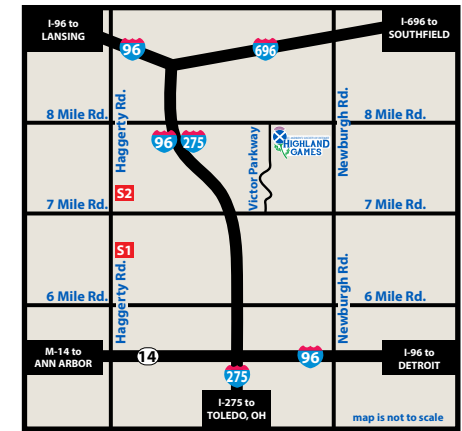
